

Dr Andrew McGrath PhD, BA(Hons) is a Lecturer in developmental psychology and forensic psychology in the School of Social Sciences and Liberal Studies at Charles Sturt University NSW. Andrew's PhD, which examined the extent to which subjective reactions to being sentenced in the Children's Court influenced subsequent offending, was awarded in 2007.
